Program Description:

The Canalway Grants Program includes up to \$1 million in competitive grants available to eligible municipalities, non-profit organizations 501-C(3), state agencies, and public authorities along the New York State Canal System for canal-related capital projects.

Program Requirements:


ELIGIBLE TYPES OF APPLICANTS:

- Municipalities
- State Agencies
- Public Authorities
- Not-for-profit Corporations


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
- Must be for Capital Improvements
- 50% Match
- \$50,000 minimum grant
- \$150,000 maximum grant
- Reimbursement basis only

Projects must be located along one of the four canals of the Canal System (Erie, Champlain, Oswego and Cayuga-Seneca),



Or trail linkages or connections to existing Canalway Trail segments, or located along the historic canal alignment.





Funding can be used to increase recreational use, improve services for motorized and non-motorized boaters, increase tourism, and stimulate private investment along the canal.
