Commercial Implementation Assistance Program offering

- NYSERDA provides up to 50% of a project's cost for eligible measures, capped at \$150,000.
- The minimum project cost is \$50,000.
- Paybacks must be between 4 and 14 years.
- Applicants must first apply for incentives through the local investor-owned utility and have confirmation that the measures are not eligible.

Documentation needed to apply to the program

- Confirmation from the Utility confirming planned measures are ineligible for funding
- W-9 Tax form
- Current and complete electric utility bill to confirm Systems Benefits Charge (SBC) payments
- Proposed scope of work
- Any applicable equipment specification sheets

How to Apply

- All applications will go through the Consolidated Funding Application (CFA). A link to the CFA is on the CIAP webpage.
- Every site involved is a separate project, and will need a separate application. Multi-facility applications will not be accepted.
