II. UB Innovation Hub Program Overview

Christina Orsi, Associate Vice President, Business & Entrepreneur Partnerships, University at Buffalo

Power point presentation outlining the UB Innovation Hub and Incubator projects (available on WNYREDC website)

- Companies participating in the Innovation Hub and Incubator include startups founded by University at Buffalo faculty, researchers, and students; Roswell Park Comprehensive Cancer Center; Hauptman-Woodward Medical Research Institute; Jacobs Institute; and Kaleida Health.
- Through the Buffalo Billion, support totaling \$32 million over five years was provided for the renovation of the CBLS into a new incubator facility, pre-seed and seed funds, and support services for fostering the growth of startup companies.
- In over two years: 59 active start ups have been supported which have raised over \$31 million and created 74 jobs.

III. EDA Funding Opportunities and Regional Applications

- Through the American Rescue Plan, EDA has released several grant opportunities, three of which WNY REDC is considering applying Build Back Better Regional Challenge, Good Jobs Challenge, and Travel, Tourism & Outdoor Recreation.
- The group discussed program deadlines and the application goals that REDC-led workgroups have developed.
- ESD will submit on behalf of WNYREDC for the 10/15/2021 BBBRC deadline, with more work to come for the later programs.

IV. Review 2021 REDC Scores for State Agency CFA Programs

- Power point presentation outlining 2021 CFA applications received and scored by the WNYREDC (available on WNYREDC website) WNY received 207 applications for all state agency programs (not inclusive of rolling application ESD programs). 181 were deemed eligible for scoring and reviewed by REDC score groups.



- Dr. Rosa Gonzalez noted two additional recusals on Climate Smart Community grants for Erie County.
- The group reviewed the compiled list of all project scores, as well as projects previously submitted for ESD grant funding.

The WNYREDC voted to approve the scores on a motion to approve by Paul Brown and second by Michael Metzger. The vote carried unanimously.
