- Focused and diverse membership from the five WNY counties
- Help guide development and coordinate projects of regional importance that drive sustainable development in transportation, housing and land use
- Develop CFA project prioritization criteria or “scorecard” to advance smart growth principles
- Guide implementation of the WNY Sustainability Plan & One Region Forward initiatives
- Create web-based tools to assist communities with managing vacant properties and reinvesting along smart growth principles
