

## 2012 Regional Council Process & Consolidated Funding Applications

### Background:

The Regional Economic Development Councils are a community driven, regional approach to economic development in New York State. Each Council is made up of 20 to 30 business, academic and government leaders from throughout the Region. In 2012, the Senate and Assembly majority committees selected one member from each region to be a voting Regional Council member.

In 2011, each of the ten Regional Councils were tasked with developing a five-year strategic plan that included a comprehensive vision for economic development for that region, regional strategies to achieve that vision, and specific priority projects that are significant, regionally supported and capable of stimulating economic investment.<sup>1</sup> Empire State Development Corporation developed a competitive process in which Regional Council Strategic Plans containing recommendations for funding made by each Regional Council were reviewed by a Strategic Plan Review Committee consisting of two State Agency Commissioners and three economic development experts. Members of the 2011 Review Team included: Dall W. Forsythe, Senior Fellow at the Wagner School of Public Service at New York University and former Vice President for Finance and Operations at The Atlantic Philanthropies; Walter D. Broadnax, Professor of Public Administration at The Maxwell School of Syracuse University; Bruce J. Katz, Vice President at the Brookings Institution and founding Director of the Brookings Metropolitan Policy Program; Joan McDonald, Commissioner of the New York State Department of Transportation; and Cesar Perales, New York State Secretary of State. On December 8, 2011, the Governor and Legislative Leaders announced the winners of the first round of competition and one year later 97% of Round One projects were under contract and/or progressing.

In 2012, the Councils went a step further and produced Strategic Implementation Agendas that built upon the progress from the first round and further developed and refined their Regional Five Year Strategic Plans by undertaking four primary activities: Establishing a framework to advance the Regional Strategic Plan; Implementing the strategies laid out in the Strategic Plan; Creating a project pipeline; and providing a progress report documenting the success the Council has had in implementing its Strategic Plan. These actions were designed to encourage and accelerate implementation, performance, and collaboration within the regions. Priority projects that aligned with each region's agenda were chosen by the Councils from the applications submitted to the Consolidated Funding Application portal. These projects were published in the regions' Implementation Agendas, which are publically available online at [www.regionalcouncils.ny.gov](http://www.regionalcouncils.ny.gov). Projects were scored by both the state agencies and the Regional Councils. The agencies scored their projects based on a technical evaluation in adherence with existing funding program guidelines and awarded a project up to 80 points. The remaining 20 points were awarded by the Regional Councils, and were based off the following endorsement standards:

#### **2012 Competition:**

To incentivize the implementation process, the Regional Councils competed for \$220 million in ESD capital funds and tax credits based on their Implementation Agendas. In 2012, five awards of \$25 million were made. The competition was split into two parts:

- First, the four regions with the 2011 Best Plans competed for two awards of up to \$25 million each in capital funds. Awards were made based on the progress the Regional Councils have made implementing their strategies and evolution of their strategic plans as outlined in their submitted Implementation Agendas including any revisions or updates.
- Second, the remaining six regions competed for three awards of up to \$25 million each in capital funds. Awards were made based on the progress the Regional Councils have made implementing their strategies and evolution of their strategic plans as outlined in their submitted Implementation Agendas including any revisions or updates.

The balance of the \$25 million in capital funds was divided among the five remaining regions. Each region will also be eligible for up to \$10 million in Excelsior Tax Credits to help attract and grow business in the region.<sup>2</sup>

According to the enabling legislation as passed by the New York State legislature and signed into law by the Governor, “funding will be pursuant to a plan developed by the chief executive officer of the New York state Urban Development Corporation and based in part on a competitive selection process among the Regional Economic Development Councils and will support initiatives based on anticipated economic development benefits. Such moneys will be awarded by the New York State Urban Development Corporation at its discretion.”<sup>3</sup>

To reflect the changing nature of the competition, the 2012 Strategic Implementation Assessment Team was led by Secretary of State Cesar Peralas and included Office of General Services Commissioner Roann Destito, Tax and Finance Commissioner Thomas Mattox, Environmental Facilities Corporation CEO Matthew Driscoll and Agriculture and Markets Commissioner Darrel Aubertine with support from the Brookings Institution, vis a vis Bruce Katz and Amy Liu. The SIAT reviewed each region’s Implementation Agendas based on established criteria and also traveled to each Region to view and tour the progress first hand. Each tour included a panel presentation that allowed for ample question and answer opportunities between the SIAT and Regional Council members. Each of the ten Regional Council visits included a tour of projects funded in the 2011 CFA which demonstrated Regional Council progress and accomplishments.

The SIAT provided an assessment of each plan<sup>4</sup> and made recommendations to Kenneth Adams, President & CEO, Empire State Development Corporation of the five reports that most closely aligned with these criteria.<sup>5</sup> President Adams accepted the recommendations of the Committee and, pursuant to his statutory powers as head of the Urban Development Corporation, awarded five regions with the top Implementation Agenda up to \$40 million in funding consisting of \$25 million in capital grants and \$15 million in Excelsior tax credits for priority projects identified in their Strategic Plans. The balance of the incentives was awarded to projects identified by the Councils as in alignment with their strategies and priorities.

In addition, project sponsors applied for up to \$600 million in economic development resources available from ten state agencies through the Consolidated Funding Application (CFA). The CFA allows businesses and other entities to apply for multiple agency funding sources through a single, web-based application. Awards for CFA projects were made based on the endorsement of the local Regional Council<sup>6</sup> and the technical program review of the agencies providing resources, subject to interagency team analysis and agency discretion.<sup>7</sup>

In 2012, the CFA opened for applications on May 3 and closed on July 14. Prior to that, all details about CFA resources were made available online via the 2012 CFA Resources Available Document, the State Register and the New York State Contract Reporter. When the portal closed on July 14, agencies immediately began marking projects eligible or ineligible. All eligible projects were then made available to the Regional Councils for their scoring process and the agencies for their technical evaluation. Scores had to be finalized by September 15. After the SIAT Tours concluded, the Inter-agency team met to review the projects and make final funding decisions.

The interagency team reviewed projects based on relevant factors including Regional Councils Implementation Agendas and designation of priority projects, project alignment with regional goals and objectives, funding availability and regional need.<sup>8</sup> Priority projects are those specifically enumerated in the Regional Council Reports, receiving a score of 20 from the Regional Council, and identified as significant, regionally supported and capable of stimulating economic investment.

The interagency team once again consisted of professional staff from relevant agencies and authorities' with detailed knowledge of their respective CFA program funding. This group conducted an analytical assessment that provided the basis for project funding recommendations made by individual agencies for final approval by respective agency or authority head. As provided in the budget, the Regional Council capital fund was awarded by ESD in its discretion.

This process resulted in funding of projects that aligned with a long term, regionally generated implementation agendas and are capable of stimulating economic growth and investment.

On December 19, 2012, the Governor announced that 725 projects totaling \$738 million had been awarded through Round Two of the Regional Economic Development Council initiative. Best Plan awards were given to Central New York, Mid Hudson, Southern Tier, North Country and Finger Lakes in adherence to the competition guidelines detailed above.

## Assessment of the 2012 Progress Report

### Part One: Strategic Plan Update

#### Building on the 2011 Strategic Plan

##### A. Addressing weaknesses identified in the 2011 assessments

The Capital Region Regional Economic Development Council (CRREDC) addressed 4 of the 7 primary weaknesses identified in the 2011 assessment. The distribution of priority projects endorsed by the CRREDC improved from 2011 when it appeared to be focused on a small number of partners in the region. A SWOT analysis was provided that begins to identify the critical issues and challenges impeding growth in the region. The plan provided more specifics about collaboration and public engagement going forward, and reference was made to needing a more diversified workforce with a greater focus on professional and technical skills with the anticipated continued contraction of government employment.

Weaknesses that were not addressed included:

- A failure to identify priority projects' sources and firmness of commitment of the non-State portion of funding.
- An absence of specific economic development metrics that could measure the success of many of the strategies
- An absence of baseline data associated with performance metrics from which to gauge progress.

##### B. Building upon strengths identified in the 2011 assessment

The CRREDC continued to build upon 9 of the 10 strengths identified in 2011, most notably strong public outreach, strong collaboration, tracking of priority projects, and acknowledgement and use of the region's natural assets. There was no discussion of specific outcomes related to each strategy, but this may reflect that anticipated outcomes did not change.

#### Strategies

The overarching goals of the CRREDC strategic plan did not change, but the strategies were streamlined with a great degree of focus. Performance measures were used to assist in the prioritization of the strategies. In the original strategic plan there were 8 goals with 30 strategies identified under those goals; in the progress report the number of strategies was reduced to 14, and three of those strategies were new this year.

Each of the strategies that the CRREDC chose to focus on in 2012 clearly fell under the goals, and justification for their selection was provided.

## Implementation Agenda

The implementation agenda detailed specific projects and initiatives along with the actions, progress, and timeline for implementation for each strategy of each goal. The implementation agenda identified 17 projects receiving or requesting state funding and 17 other actions to advance the regional strategies. The actions varied in their specificity. For example, action items for the ALCOA Mohawk River Multi-use Trail include "complete preliminary design" and "construction of the ALCOA trail" with a specific month and year timeline, while the City of Glens Falls Redevelopment and Connection Plan for Pruyns Island had only a general description of the action and no timeline for further action.

In identifying the region's priority projects, the CRREDC identified a larger number of small ticket items that appear to reach a greater number of entities within the region; however, the priority projects appear to be geographically focused in three of the region's eight counties. Furthermore, the priority projects selected were not comprehensive and there was no evidence that the projects selected were projects that would best advance the strategies.

The progress report does list primary and secondary strategies that are addressed by the proposed priority projects, but does not provide clear articulation of how the proposed projects would advance the strategies. This gives the appearance that the CRREDC was more project-focused and backed into the strategies, whereas the strategies should be providing the framework for moving forward and for selection of the projects. Future efforts should follow the project description template in the guidebook more closely by including an explanation of how the priority project would advance one or more strategies and a budget narrative.

While not a defined criteria, project readiness did not appear to be a strong consideration in selection of priority projects identified for competitive capital funding as a number of those projects were identified as being in the "planning" or "preliminary design/engineering" phase.

## Part Two: Progress Made Implementing Strategies

### Progress

#### A. Organizational progress

CRREDC work groups were retooled to ensure greater success in expanding outreach, engaging stakeholders, filling the project pipeline, and supporting projects. The Metrics and Monitoring workgroup developed a process and standards for monitoring projects, and coordinated with the State to ensure effective and efficient tracking and reporting. The Plan Implementation workgroup developed an implementation agenda for the strategic plan, provided oversight of the process, and compiled project progress reports and deliverables. The Strategic Plan Advancement workgroup expanded the SWOT analysis and focused strategies to advance the CRREDC's goals.

The Project Pipeline workgroup developed a process to identify projects advancing strategies of the regional plan and engaged business and community leaders to develop new projects to fill the short- and long-term pipeline. They met with business and community leaders to ensure that potential project sponsors were aware of how to advance project ideas.

Once the CRREDC selected the priority projects, 3 public meetings were held in the region to provide updates of plan progress, the status of the next round of projects, and opportunities for the public to offer ideas and feedback on the plan.

The CRREDC established ten official collaborations in 2012, relating to media, education, financial services, healthcare, tourism, and arts, among others. For example, the CRREDC established a Leaders Forum comprised of over 20 Presidents or CEOs of major companies and institutions in the region to assist the CRREDC in its efforts to develop action oriented projects, unify structure, develop identity and brand, create value proposition, and provide funding. However, the level of activity of the coalitions was unclear.

## **B. Examples of progress**

The progress report lists specific projects and initiatives for each strategy of each goal, including descriptions of progress on some of the 2011 CFA funded projects, actions taken, progress made, and the timeline for implementation. Most projects were listed as complete, on schedule, or ongoing. Actions taken range from holding meetings, to entering into contracts, to construction activities. The specificity of actions varies.

The Destination Windham project to enhance the storm water collection and conveyance system to protect existing infrastructure at Windham Mountain was completed over 8 months ahead of schedule. The “Open for Business” Consolidation Initiative to streamline economic development efforts in Warren and Washington County was on schedule to move under one roof by the end of 2012.

The City Station project in Troy, which planned a mixed use development structure, was completed ahead of schedule. It is now home to RPI student housing and retail space. Construction of a parking garage and apartment space, along with more retail space, is scheduled for the end of the summer.

## **Leveraging of Resources**

For 2012-13, the CRREDC proposes to use \$36.7 million in ESD capital funds to leverage \$292.0 million in non-state funds to support its priority projects. Thirty-three of 44 projects have some degree of leverage listed, although the private funding sources are not documented.

The region has developed new and expanded partnerships with private, not-for-profit, and other government entities relating to technical assistance, staff expertise, and institutional resources. This is evidenced by the coalitions and Leaders Forum established in the last year.

A few priority projects funded in 2011 are creating leverageable resources, mostly in the form of collaborative efforts. For instance, the NY CAP Research Alliance is providing a “forum for sharing new ideas and discoveries, identifying collaborative opportunities, and developing joint initiatives for funding.” Likewise, the High Performance Computing Consortium is helping to promote greater integration of high performance computing technologies to advance technological advances in other industries.

## Performance Measures

The progress report states that progress of strategic plan goals will be measured using specific metrics or indicators of success, and that this feedback will be used to validate and/or refine its approach to plan fulfillment. Two sets of performance measures were identified by the CRREDC.

First, a metric dashboard was presented with some data shown as monitoring progress, but some metrics seemed inconsistent with the goals they were associated with. For instance, the “build a superhighway” goal has a strategy to “build smart, modern infrastructure with a focus on preparing our community for sustainable growth and creation of new wealth,” but the metrics dashboard identifies electricity and natural gas prices as indicators for this. It is unclear how regional actions could significantly impact electricity or natural gas prices.

The second set of performance measures listed a total of 42 metrics for the listed goals and each metric was identified as being derived either from a secondary data source or from a primary data source. However, the report omitted definitions and data sources for the indicators, explanation of the significance of the indicator, and relevant observations.

## Process

The CRREDC expanded outreach to be more inclusive across industries and locales. The CRREDC conducted regular meetings that included a standing public segment, public meetings to seek input, and one-to-one and one-to-many meetings, and surveys.

Results of the work of the CRREDC were shared through the CRREDC website, stakeholder outreach, special events, and media outreach (e.g. press releases, Capital Region Media Coalition, PSAs, social media).
