# **REPORT FOR 03.17.14**

## **EDUCATION & WORKFORCE**

Meeting held Tuesday, March 4<sup>th</sup> @ 9am with Brian Hunt, Superintendent, Edmeston Central School District to discuss STEM collaboration between BOCES and schools in the region. Attendees were Carolyn Lewis, Brian Hunt, Christian Mercurio. Highlights:

- Edmeston is taking the next step in regional STEM curriculum development; affiliating with Project Lead The Way and adjacent school districts to expand High School STEM and introduce Middle School programs.
- Superintendents in Otsego County are in regular communication on this, and are advancing the ball.
- Gateway to Technology programs being proposed for Edmeston:
  - o Robotics & CAD modules
  - o Principles of Engineering
  - Computer-Integrated Manufacturing 3-D Printer & CNC Machine
- Includes retrofit of wood shop into mini CGAM-style laboratory
- Have applied to Community Foundation and Home Depot for Funding
- Edmeston is actively seeking to build the student pipeline to Herkimer College, FMCC, and SUNY-IT programs.
