






WNY Population Changes, Ages 20-39 and 40-59, 1990-2010
















Total wages earned in WNY 2000-2012





Total number of firms operating in WNY 2000-2012





Percentage of minorities making up total WNY labor population 2000-2011




HS Graduation Rate
