

PLANNING PROCESS TIMELINE












Which of these factors should the Finger Lakes Regional Economic Development Council focus on over the next ten years? Pick your top three.

"Public transportation options are critical for diversifying our workforce."







- Identify the next mega-site


- Educate stakeholders on the value of public investments

- Conduct community-wide capacity evaluation of water/wastewater limitations




